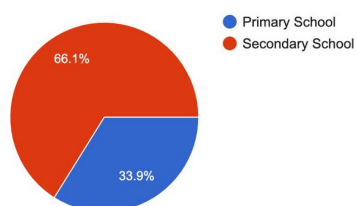

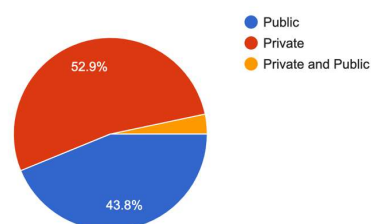

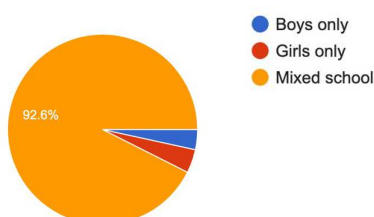
School Level of the Teach4SDGs Educators (Cohort 1)



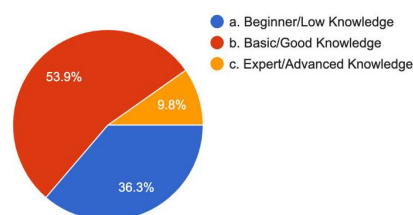
School Type of the Teach4SDGs Educators (Cohort 1)



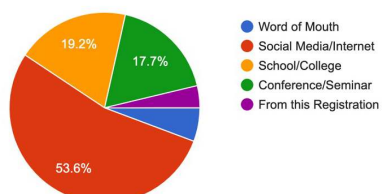
School Category of the Teach4SDGs Educators (Cohort 1)



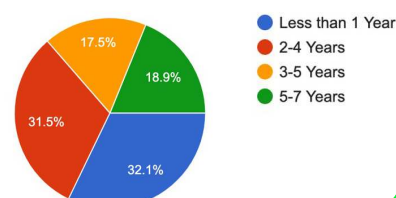
Knowledge Ratings on SDGs with the Teach4SDGs Educators.
